\$30* entry fee covers all four rail jams, event T-shirt, and raffle drawing entry! The sooner, the better 'cause it will still cost you \$30* if you choose any time you join! Lift tickets will be available to paying competitors that do not have a season pass at that Fight's location for a discounted rate of ½ off normal Friday night pricing. Competitors must be 18 years or older and fill out a registration form and a liability waiver from both hills. Competitors under 18 will need a parent's signature to compete.
